Mr. Dale Everett Peck, 87, of Fortuna, Missouri, passed away Sunday, May 16, 2004 at Bothwell Regional Health Center in Sedalia. He was born October 27, 1916 in Seldon, Kansas, the son of Jefferson Harrison and Frances Ellen Gustafeson Peck.

He was raised mostly in Colorado, and married Evelyn A. Anderson on June 2, 1945 in Elko, Nevada. He owned a metal salvage yard in Salt Lake City for several years before moving back to Colorado where he owned the Aurora Garage in Aurora, Colorado with his brother. He retired and moved to Fortuna in 1976.

He is survived by his wife, Evelyn A. Peck of the home; one son, Pastor Robert G. Peck of Fortuna; two daughters, Lynn Eisele of Holbrook, Arizona, and Sharon Pride of Berthoud, Colorado; one sister, Nila V.
