Frank Peter Renick, Jr., age 74, of Gravois Mills, Missouri, passed away Sunday, December 17, 2023 in Cameron, Missouri. He was born April 18, 1949 in Sullivan, Missouri, a son of Frank Peter Renick, Sr. and Edda (Bowman) Renick.
