Charles F. "Bud" Pryor, age 72, of Versailles, passed away Sunday morning, June 1, 2003 at Capital Region Medical Center in Jefferson City. He was born January 9, 1931 in Clay County, Missouri, the son of Ted R. and Ruby Williams Pryor.
