Ralph D. "Mack" McHenry, age 70, of Stover, passed away Monday, March 23, 2009, at the Lake Regional Health System in Osage Beach. He was born August 12, 1938, in Cole Center, Pennsylvania, the son of the late Elwin Clair and Marguerite E. Wilkins McHenry.
