Randy Clarke, age 61, of Gravois Mills, passed away Monday, April 16, 2012, at his home. He was born January 9, 1951, in Kansas City, Missouri, the son of the late Charles E. and Ruth B. Butler Clarke.

Randy was highly respected in his own business as a "handyman" on the west side of the lake and was a member of Tony's Point Mutual Water Improvement Association. In the past, he had served as a diver for the Water Patrol at the Lake of the Ozarks and as an Assistant Scoutmaster for the Boy Scouts. Randy graduated from Colorado State University in 1973, and his outstanding research has been published in various scientific journals.

He is survived by his daughter, Courtney Kohler and husband Matthew of Jefferson City, Missouri; a granddaughter, Emma Sue, due in July; his sister, Nancy Burlington and husband John of Sun City, Arizona; and many other relatives and friends. Randy will be remembered as a thoughtful and diligent man, as well as a loving, educative, and involved father.

A small memorial service will be held on Friday, May 11, 2012, at 6:00 pm on Tony's Point. In lieu of flowers, a memorial fund in Randy's memory has been established at the Bank of Versailles.
