Dedicated Wife, Loving Mother, Grandmother, and Great Grandmother, Reita Mae Hammond (nee Riley), age 93, of Versailles, MO, passed away from natural causes May 9th, 2016.

Reita was born in Marceline, MO to Owen Ettie Riley and Wilma West Riley (nee Phillips) on August 29th, 1922. She graduated from Marceline HS in 1940.
