Richard F. Timmermeyer, age 75, of Laurie, passed away Thursday, December 20, 2007, at the Laurie Care Center. He was born July 4, 1932, in Wichita, Kansas, the son of the late George F. and Susan Marie Ternes Timmermeyer.
