Richard Franklin Madole, age 94, of Barnett, passed away Saturday, August 14, 2004, at St. Mary's Health Center in Jefferson City. He was born August 16, 1909, near Barnett, the son of Hiram M. and Arminda K. Nichols Madole.

He graduated from Versailles High School in 1925, and earned a Bachelor of Science Degree in Chemistry from the University of Missouri in 1929.
