James Marvin Riggs, age 81, of Versailles, passed away Tuesday morning, November 30, 2004 at Bothwell Regional Health Center in Sedalia. He was born September 4, 1923 in Morgan County, Missouri, the son of Osborn Lee and Lillie Mabel Broyles Riggs.

He was united in marriage on March 12, 1944 with Dulcie Virginia Burk, who preceded him in death on November 3, 1971. On August 22, 1972 he married Lois Cable, who survives of the home.

Marvin was an over the road truck driver for Jack Cooper Transport for 13 years, and later worked at Fasco Industries for 5 years, and was a custodian and bus driver for the Morgan County R-II School District in Versailles for 7 years. He was a U.S. Air Force veteran and served in the South Pacific, member of the V.F.W. Post in Gravois Mills, and was a member and deacon of the First Baptist Church in Versailles.
