Known as "The Greek" by friends and colleagues, Robert departed from this world on January 1, 2016 to reunite with his loving wife of over 60 years, Faye Lucille Dakopolos who had preceded him in death.

Born September 14, 1926, to Henry A. Dakopolos and Nettie L. Leslie in Kansas City, Missouri, he spent much of his life in the service of his home state.

Throughout his 89 years of life, he honored his family with dedicated services to home and country; as both a loving husband and father, and also a WWII U.S. Navy veteran, having served aboard the USS Sea Dog until 1946.

Alumni of the University of Missouri with a Bachelors of Law, Bob graduated with a Juris Doctor from The University of Missouri at Kansas City Law School in 1953.

During his distinguished career as a Jackson County, Missouri, Chief Assistant Prosecuting Attorney and Trial Director, Bob served under Joe Teasdale, Ralph Martin, and Albert Riederer.

He retired to his beloved home at Lake of the Ozarks in 1989 where he enjoyed a peaceful and pleasant life surrounded by friends, family, and loved

ones.

Robert is survived by son David Andrew and daughter-in-law Mitzi Jane Dakopolos, son Steven Robert Dakopolos and his grandchildren Christian Andrew and Persephone Dakopolos.
