Robert Henry “Bob” Miller, of Sunrise Beach, Missouri, fortified with the sacraments of Holy Mother Church, died, May 22, 2023, surrounded by his loving family. He was born October 21, 1942 in Mobile, Alabama to Eugene D. and Irma (Walpole) Miller.
