Robert Athel Taylor, age 78, passed away Thursday, September 4, 2014, in Kansas City, Missouri. Robert was born November 9, 1935, in Versailles, Missouri, to Athel Taylor and Ella Hilderbrand Taylor.

Robert graduated from Stover High School with the class of 1953. After graduating, Robert enlisted in the military. Later, he was honorably discharged from the United States Army.

Robert moved to Kansas City, Missouri, in search of employment. He was a teamster and worked as an over-the-road truck driver for Railway Express Agency and Montgomery Ward. After retiring from truck driving, he accepted employment with the Kansas City Missouri School District where he worked for an additional ten years.
