H. Dean Robinson, age 84, of Sunrise Beach, passed away April 23, 2004, at the Ozark Care Center in Osage Beach. He was born December 15, 1919, in Sedalia, the son of Howard E. and Vesta Dean Robinson.

Dean was raised around Sedalia and graduated from Smith-Cotton High School. He served in the Army Air Force as an Aviation Technician. Following his military service, Dean worked in construction until his retirement. After moving to the Lake of the Ozarks in 1968, he continued to enjoy his travels around the country. He entered into the Linn Creek Lodge #152 in 1976, and continued to participate in their craftwork until his illness in November 2003. He was also a 29 year member of the American Legion Zack Wheat Post #624 of Sunrise Beach, a member of the York Rite Abou Ben Adhem Shrine Temple in Springfield and the Scottish Rite Temple.
