Rodney Russell Shaw, age 73, of Stover, passed away Friday, November 6, 2009, at Capital Region Medical Center in Jefferson City. He was born March 28, 1936, in Weiser, Idaho, the son of the late Herbert Russell and Elizabeth Wahl Shaw.
