Roger Alfred Forck, age 71, of Gravois Mills, Missouri, passed away Sunday, December 24, 2023, at Good Shepherd Care Center, Versailles, Missouri. He was born March 26, 1952, in Jefferson City, Missouri, a son of Alfred B. and Rayma B. (Vanloo) Forck.
