



Ross Henry Huff

January 6, 1929 - November 22, 2011

Ross Henry Huff, age 82, of Barnett, passed away peacefully, November 22, 2011, at the Good Shepherd Care Center in Versailles after years of poor health. He was born January 6, 1929, in Versailles, the son of the late Joe and Ruth Ferguson Huff. He was the youngest and the last surviving of their six children.

While serving in the United States Army in the Korean Conflict, he and Shirley June Capps were married on July 9, 1951, and she preceded him in death on July 29, 2011. Together they had two children, Earl Huff, who preceded him in death, and Robin Huff of Barnett.

A good man, Ross had no formal religious leanings, but did live by a code that included working hard and helping others. In addition to working full time for over 20 years at Clark's Tire, he also operated a farm raising both crops and cattle.

Along the way, he helped innumerable people, from friends and neighbors, to his brother's tragically orphaned children, and of course his own children and grandchildren.

In addition to his daughter, Robin, he is survived by three grandchildren, Joshua Huff of Versailles, and Ashley Huff and Lacey Anthony both of Sedalia;

and several great-grandchildren, nieces and nephews. In addition to his parents, wife, and son, he was preceded in death by two grandsons, Chris Powell and Aaron Powell.

Funeral services will be held at 2:30 p.m., Saturday, November 26, at the Kidwell-Garber Funeral Home in Versailles with Pastor Jim Kruse officiating.
