Roy Allen Simpson, 72, of Gravois Mills, Missouri, passed away Tuesday, April 18, 2017 at Lake Regional Hospital, Osage Beach, Missouri. He was born July 3, 1944 in Kansas City, Missouri, a son of Roy Herman and Willie Mae (Johnson) Simpson.

On November 18, 1962 in Miami, Oklahoma, he was united in marriage to Tobi Ann Tavernaro. Together they shared the past fifty-four years of marriage.

He was preceded in death by his parents and a sister, Norma Jean Young.
