Samuel Curtis Mooney, age 69, of Sunrise Beach, passed away Monday, December 16, 2019, at Lake Regional Health System in Osage Beach. He was born December 7, 1950, at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri, a son of the late Charles Wesley and Millie Lorene (Layman) Mooney.

On December 20, 1975, at Rock Harbor Resort in Sunrise Beach, he was united in marriage to his surviving wife, Cecelia (Glick) Mooney.

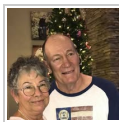
