Sandra Sue Wyssmann, age 74, of Gravois Mills, Missouri, passed away on Saturday, August 23, at Lake Regional Hospital in Osage Beach, Missouri, from complications of Multi Focal Motor Neuropathy.

Sandra was born October 28, 1950 in Kingsley, IA to Roy and Dorothy (Petersen) Schieuer. Growing up in Kingsley, she graduated from Kingsley-Pierson High School in 1969. She will always be remembered for her kind spirit, love of her family, and cheerful and positive disposition.
