Sharon K. Kreglinger-Coffman, age 68, of Burlington, Kentucky, passed away Thursday, August 15, 2013, at her home surrounded by family. She was born March 29, 1945, in Stover, Missouri, the daughter of Loyd Paul and Hazel Marie Marriott-Kreglinger.
