Stella L. Shore, age 86, of Versailles, passed away Thursday, February 10, 2005, at the Good Shepherd Care Center in Versailles. She was born on November 18, 1918, near Versailles, to Tony and Mary Woods Stringer.

On May 16, 1936, she was married in Stover to Mancil E. Shore who preceded her in death on May 19, 1941. On January 14, 1945, in Versailles, she married Roy M. Shore, who survives of the home.

Mrs. Shore graduated from Versailles High School in 1935. She worked at Tweedies in Jefferson City and later in Versailles. She worked for Barnes Jewelry Store and later for Davenport Jewelry in Versailles.
