Davis L. Sidebottom, age 97, of Versailles, passed away Friday, June 2, 2006 at the Good Shepherd Care Center in Versailles. He was born April 4, 1909 in Morgan County, the son of Charles T. and Rosa Cooper Sidebottom.

On July 31, 1927 Davis Sidebottom was united in marriage in St. John, Kansas to Berness Leona Andrew who preceded him in death on June 28, 1995.
