Edwin D. Smith, age 74, of Laurie, passed away Friday morning, January 16, 2004 at the Harry S. Truman Memorial Veterans Medical Center in Columbia. He was born April 21, 1929 in Atwood, Colorado, the son of Henry E. and Bessie Marcum Smith.

He was united in marriage on June 19, 1949 in Fayette, Missouri with Martha Sue Overstreet, who survives of the home.

Mr. Smith was a bus driver for Greyhound and later owned and operated Smith's Mobile Home Service near Laurie for 34 years. He was a U.S. Army veteran of the Korean War and member of the V.F.W.
