Stephen Arthur Calahan, age 73, of Versailles, Missouri, passed away, Monday, May 17, 2021 at SSM Health St. Mary's Hospital, Jefferson City, Missouri. He was born, October 4, 1947 in Van Nuys, California, a son of William Arthur and Mary Margaret (Speck) Calahan.

On October 15, 1971 in St. Louis, Missouri, he was united in marriage to Nancy Jean Foppe. Together they shared forty-nine years of marriage.

Steve was raised in St. Louis, Missouri and was a graduate of Affton High School in the class of 1968. He served his country proudly in the United States Navy during the Vietnam War.
