Lena Inez Stevens, 94, of Versailles, died Thursday, Feb. 20, 2003, at the Good Shepherd Care Center in Versailles.

She was born April 7, 1908, in Camden County, a daughter of John and Lucinda Crane. On Aug. 8, 1928, she was married to George Calvin "Cal" Stevens, who died Jan. 4, 1999.
