Donald Lee Stevenson, age 62, of Windsor and Blue Springs, passed away Thursday morning, July 31, 2003, at Independence Regional Health Center in Independence. He was born October 29, 1940, in Versailles, Missouri, the son of Glen C. and Anna Jane Ellis Stevenson.

He was united in marriage on October 30, 1959, with Maxine Allison, who survives of the home.

Don was a truck driver for most of his life and founded, owned and operated the Stevenson Trucking Corporation of Blue Springs, Mo. He served as president and vice-president of the Missouri Dump Truckers Association. He told of an experience of salvation that happened during his early twenties, and believed his Maker had watched over him through the many trials of his life.
