Don C. Stockham, age 80, of Versailles, passed away Monday evening, November 1, 2004 at the Good Shepherd Care Center in Versailles. He was born July 25, 1924 in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, the son of C.S. and Millie Loffer Stockham.
