



Teddy "Ted" Hoover

January 19, 1943 - August 4, 2011

Teddy "Ted" Hoover, age 68, of Sunrise Beach, passed away Thursday, August 4, 2011, at St. Mary's Health Center in Jefferson City. He was born January 19, 1943, in Kansas City, Missouri, the son of Vernon L. and Dorothy Mae Ann Zugenbuhler Hoover.

On August 13, 1966, he was united in marriage to Donna Adams, who preceded him in death on July 14, 2004.

Ted owned and operated Ted's Surplus in Sunrise Beach for several years.

He is survived by his daughter, Mindi Meyers and husband Jamie of Sunrise Beach, Missouri; his mother, Dorothy Hoover of Sunrise Beach, Missouri; five grandchildren; his brothers, Larry Hoover, Sr. and Kent Hoover both of Sunrise Beach, Missouri; his sister, Jo Ellen Hoover of Gravois Mills, Missouri; and many other relatives and friends.
