Terrance Lynn “Terry” Yoder, age 55, of Gravois Mills, Missouri, passed away Friday, July 13, 2018, in his home. He was born February 25, 1963, in Sarasota, Florida, a son of Raymond Edward and Martha Lou (Slabaugh) Yoder, brother to Tamera “Tammy” (Yoder) Loganbill.

Terry was raised in Sarasota, Florida and at the age of eleven moved to Stover, Missouri, alongside his parents and sister, Tammy. Then, later moved to Versailles, Missouri, where he graduated from in 1981.
