### TOM MARLOW

Thomas Eugene Marlow, age 70, of Eldon, Missouri, passed away Tuesday, February 14, 2023 at Capital Region Medical Center, Jefferson City, Missouri. He was born March 12, 1952 in Kansas City, Missouri, a son of the late Billy Eugene and Florence Joan (Heidelberger) Marlow.

On May 31, 1986 in Blue Springs, Missouri, he was united in marriage to Charemon Renee Eakin. They shared thirty-six years of marriage.

Tom was a graduate of Grain Valley High School in the class of 1970. He received a bachelor's degree from Southwest Missouri State University (now Missouri State University) and a master's degree from Central Missouri State University (now University of Central Missouri) in education. He began his career as a teacher in Strasburg, Missouri. He retired from the Camdenton R-III School District after teaching for twenty-five years. While in Camdenton, he was the soccer coach.

He was the pastor of Calvary Family Tabernacle in Otterville, Missouri. He became a Christian and found his Savior at a Billy Graham crusade expo in 1972 that he attended with his cousin, Kenny Raye Reeder. He was later introduced to Campus Crusade for Christ while in college and worked as a

staff member for the organization in San Bernardino, California.

In his spare time, he enjoyed being outdoors, especially fishing and mushroom hunting. He had a knack for growing roses and orchids. Most of all, he loved spending time with his family and friends.
