



Verlyn Dean Bohling

July 14, 1934 - May 28, 2014

Verlyn Dean Bohling, son of Richard and Hermine Bohling, was born July 14, 1934, at Hebron, Nebraska. He departed this life on May 28, 2014, at the age of 79 years.

While still very young, his parents moved to a farm near Davenport, Nebraska, where he graduated from high school. He attended Midland College at Fremont, Nebraska, then moved to Lincoln to work. There, he met his future wife, Gladys Schardt. They married July 25, 1954 and together shared nearly 60 years of marriage. To this union three children were born.

He was preceded in death by his parents. Survivors include his wife, Gladys, of the home; one daughter, Pamela and husband David Wills; two sons, Perry and wife Kathryn Bohling and Kent Bohling; seven grandchildren, Bryce and wife Jennifer Wills, Casey and wife Janel Wills, Elizabeth and husband Evan Godwin, Alexi, Michael, Blake and Baylor Bohling and five great-granddaughters, Kayla, Shelby, Emily, April and Sadie Wills. Also surviving is one sister, Glennis Stephens; two brothers, Wayne and James Bohling and many nephews and nieces.

Most of Verlyn's career was selling insurance. He began working for Lutheran Brotherhood in 1955, moving to Manhattan, Kansas. In 1960, he began working for Kansas Farm Bureau working as agency manager at Mound City

(Linn County) and Garnett (Anderson County) until retirement in 1998. At that time, he and Gladys moved to the Lake of the Ozarks where the family had vacationed for many years.

He enjoyed boating, traveling, playing bridge and time spent with family. He loved sports, especially watching his children and grandchildren until the time of his death.

He was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith and was a member of the Kent Memorial Lutheran Church in Sunrise Beach.

Memorial services will be held at Kent Memorial Lutheran Church on Saturday, May 31st, at 3:00 p.m. with a visitation beginning at 2:00 p.m. Entombment will follow in the Kent Memorial Columbarium. Memorial donations may be made to the Kent Memorial Building Fund or the American Heart Association.
