



Reverend Vincent D. "Birdman" Hannon

July 24, 1955 - July 11, 2015

Reverend Vincent D. "Birdman" Hannon, age 59, of Gravois Mills, passed away Saturday, July 11, 2015, at Capital Region Medical Center in Jefferson City. He was born July 24, 1955, in Wilmington, North Carolina, a son of the late Richard Samuel and Lucille Pearl (Lewis) Hannon.

On February 27, 2009, at the Versailles First Assembly of God Church, he was united in marriage to his surviving wife, Jolene Angel Hannon.

Vincent was a veteran of the United States Army, having served in Vietnam.

He owned and operated Budget Body in Eldon until he was no longer able to work due to his health.

Vincent attended the Versailles First Assembly of God Church. He was currently serving as the pastor of the Wilderness Church of Morgan County. He was also the leader of the Wilderness Boys, where he counseled troubled youth. Vincent was a member of a Civil War history club.

His favorite hobbies were woodworking and training dogs for security and therapy.
