Virginia Rose Schad, age 86, of Barnett, passed away Saturday, September 29, 2018, at SSM Health St. Mary's Hospital in Jefferson City. She was born December 10, 1931, in Barnett, a daughter of the late Robert Neil and Emma Broox (McConnell) Sharples.

On September 17, 1949, in Syracuse, she was united in marriage to Johnnie Alvin Schad, who preceded her in death on July 17, 1985.

Virginia was employed for many years as a pharmacy technician at Walmart in Versailles. In addition, she was a secretary for Hazel Dell Insurance and an auction clerk for Jack Hutchison for several years. She worked alongside her husband, Johnnie, farming for thirty-two years, as well as her sons for the last thirty-three years.

Virginia was a lifelong member of Hopewell Union Church in Barnett. She was the church pianist for seventy-five years and was active in the Bible school and Sunday school programs. Virginia served on the Hopewell Cemetery board since 1973. For twenty years, she was a board member of Good Shepherd Care Center, as well as a longtime member of Farm Bureau and the Friendly Neighbors Quilting Club.

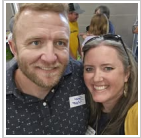

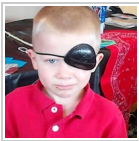

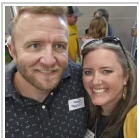
