Wade Alfred Carver, age 74, of Gravois Mills, Missouri, passed away Wednesday, August 23, 2023 at his home. He was born May 2, 1949 in Kansas City, Kansas, a son of Alfred Abraham and Rita Delores (Weis) Carver.

On May 7, 1977, he was united in marriage to Carolyn Sue Faulkner and they shared forty-six happy years.

Wade was a life-long resident of the Gravois Mills, Missouri area, in the location known as Carver, Missouri, prior to the formation of the Lake of the Ozarks.
