



Wade Wood Huffman

Wade Wood Huffman, age 86, of Versailles, passed away Thursday, August 31, 2017, at SSM Health St. Mary's Hospital in Jefferson City. He was born October 24, 1930, in Morgan County, a son of the late Oliver P. and Elizabeth "Kate" (Friedley) Huffman.

On April 22, 1977, in Versailles, he was united in marriage to his surviving wife, Aretta (Capps) Silvey Huffman.

Wade was a veteran of the United States Marine Corps having served in the Korean Conflict. In March of 1954, he was honorably discharged with the rank of Corporal.

He starting his teaching career in 1962 at the Gravois Mills School where he taught fifth and sixth grades. Later, he taught fourth, fifth, seventh and eighth grades and the Title 1 Remedial Program at the Morgan County R-II School in Versailles retiring after thirty-four years.
