Wandalee Pearl Zimmerman, age 88, of Versailles, passed away Thursday, January 22, 2009, at the Good Shepherd Care Center in Versailles. She was born October 9, 1920, in Morgan County, Missouri, the daughter of the late Edwin Lee and Tracy Pearl Ash White.
