Arthur Wesley Wade, age 85, of Barnett, Missouri, passed away Tuesday, September 29, 2020 at Capital Region Hospital.

Wes was born June 23, 1935 in Indianola, Iowa to Hazel (Bishop) Wade and Percival Arthur Wade. Wes moved with his family to Miller, South Dakota when he was a child. He graduated from Miller High School and enlisted in the South Dakota National Guard.
