



## C. William "Bill" Hunter

October 11, 1939 - March 22, 2011

Bill Hunter, age 71, of Sunrise Beach, MO, departed this life on Tuesday, March 22, 2011, at the University of Missouri Hospital in Columbia, MO, of a traumatic head injury.

Bill was born on October 11, 1939, in Kansas City, MO, the son of Clarence W. and Jacqueline Hunter. The family later moved to the Lake of the Ozarks where he graduated from Camdenton High School.

In 1977, he was united in marriage to Jeri in Sedalia, MO, and together they shared the last 34 years.
