William C. "Bill" Lagergren, age 85, of Laurie, passed away Sunday, February 11, 2024, at University of Missouri Hospital and Clinics in Columbia. He was born April 17, 1938, in Kansas City, Missouri, son of the late Vernon Leroy and Helen Dorothy (Grunau) Lagergren.
