



## William Robert Turner

November 15, 1948 - July 27, 2021

William Robert Turner passed away Tuesday, July 27, 2021 at 6:20 p.m. in his home. He was born November 15, 1948 in Eldon, Missouri, a son of Robert B. Turner and Mary Francis (Morris) Mullins.

He moved to Indiana when he was about one year old and lived there until the age of twelve where he attended Lowell Elementary. In 1960, the family moved to Sedalia, Missouri and he attended Broadway Grade School and graduated from Smith-Cotton High School. He entered the United States Army on October 31, 1967 during the Vietnam War. His basic training and vehicle wheel mechanic training were in Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri. He went to Fort Benning, Georgia for tank mechanic school. He was assigned to the First Signal Brigade in Bangkok, Thailand. After being honorably discharged, he worked heavy construction for Carpenter's Union 945 and was a millwright until he retired. He owned Main Street Used Cars for a short time.

Survivors include his wife of forty years, Denise Turner; a sister, Dee Ensor and husband Harold and his nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his parents and a sister, Jeanne Beth Mann.

A celebration of life will be held at 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, August 4, 2021 at Kidwell-Garber Funeral Home of Versailles. Full military honors will be

conferred at the service. Inurnment will be at a later date in Glensted Cemetery.

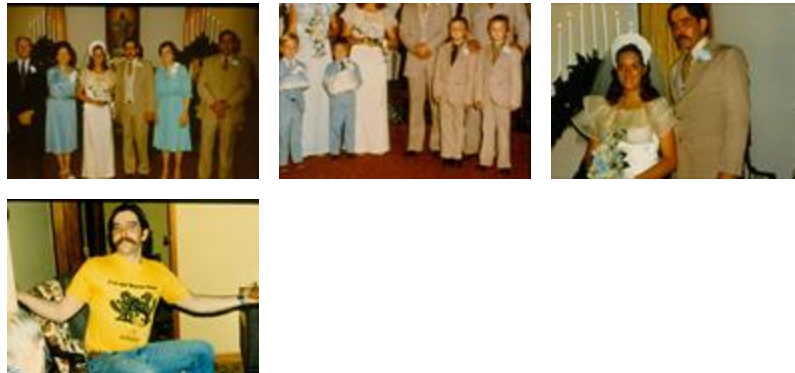
