Thomas G. Woolsey, age 86, of Versailles, passed away Friday, December 26, 2003 at the Good Shepherd Care Center in Versailles. He was born April 13, 1917 in Warrensburg, MO, the son of Thomas G. and Alpha Louise Gillum Woolsey.

He was united in marriage on February 9, 1944 with Helen Crowder, who preceded him in death on July 22, 1995.

Mr. Woolsey was an attorney in Versailles for many years and a partner in the law firm of Woolsey & Yarger. He served as Prosecuting Attorney of Morgan County, the State Senate from 1960 until 1968 where he was the Minority Leader, and on the Board of Governors for the Missouri Bar Association. He was a B-24 navigator and veteran of World War II.

Survivors include one son, Thomas G. Woolsey Jr., of Dallas, TX; one daughter, Debra Lee McKeon of Chesterfield, MO; six grandchildren and one great-grandson. In addition to his parents and wife he was preceded in death by two brothers and one sister.

Funeral services were held be at 2:00 p.m. Tuesday, December 30, at the Kidwell-Garber Funeral Home in Versailles. Vocal selections of "Old Rugged Cross" and "In The Garden" were sung. Interment was in the Versailles
